Minimum Hiring Qualifications/Essential Job Functions: This position is performed under immediate supervision. Applicants must be highly motivated, qualified individuals interested in helping the police department accomplish its mission of safeguarding the lives and property of its citizens by proactively building and strengthening community relationships. This position involves a variety of functions relating to operations of the police department including but not limited to: exercise considerable independent judgment at all times, react quickly and effectively to stressful situations, carry out oral and written instructions, work with people in a polite, courteous and firm manner, work varied shifts. Job Qualifications: a U. S. Citizen, at least 21 years of age, a high school graduate or possess a General Education Degree (G.E.D.), possess a valid Virginia's Driver's License, able to bend, stoop and lift items weighing 25 lbs and occasional lifting of items weighing 50 pounds or more. Certified Police Officer is desired; trainees will be considered. Applicants must be knowledgeable of and practice safe work habits. Applicants must successfully complete an oral review board and thorough background check that includes a drug screen, credit history check, physical and psychological examination as well as driver's license check and criminal history all in accordance with the minimum standards set forth in Virginia State Code 15.2-1705.
