Town Seeks Input on Consideration of Reconfiguration of Main Street

Altavista, Va. – The Altavista Town Council is seeking public input on a proposed plan to reconfigure the current traffic pattern on US 29 Business, Main Street, in Altavista and a Community Information Meeting to discuss this possible project will be held on September 7, 2016 from 4:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. in Council’s Chambers of the Altavista Town Hall (510 7th Street), Altavista, Virginia. VDOT and Town staff will be on hand to receive comments and review conceptual design.

The proposal is to have one lane of travel in either direction and a center turn lane from Main Street at Pittsylvania Avenue to Main Street at Wood Lane, the current four-lane section. The proposed project is expected to improve safety for motorists and pedestrians along this major town roadway by reducing vehicle and pedestrian conflicts and by providing a dedicated lane for turning movements.

The public’s input is being sought to assist Town Council in determining whether to submit a resolution of support to the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) following the September 13, 2016 Regular Town Council meeting.
