NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
AMENDMENTS TO ZONING ORDINANCE

The Altavista Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on Monday, April 1, 2019 at 5:00 PM in the Council Room of the Altavista Municipal Building, 510 Seventh Street. The purpose of this public hearing is to consider proposed text amendments to the Town Zoning Ordinance adding provisions governing food banks. The specific code sections to be amended and added are as follows:

Amend Sec. 86-32 – Use Types to add a definition for “Food banks”

Food banks would be added to permitted uses in the following zoning districts:

Sec. 86-322. C-1 (Local Commercial) as a “by right” use

Sec. 86-352. C-2 (General Commercial) Special Use Permit required

Sec. 86-382. M (Industrial Districts) as a “by right” use

A new Sec. 86-482.1 “Food banks” would be added to provide development standards for food banks in the town.

The text of the proposed changes may be examined during regular business hours in the Altavista Town Hall. A copy is also available on the Town of Altavista website, www.altavistava.gov, on the “Home” page under the “Altavista Updates” section.

The public and all interested parties are invited to attend this public hearing to make their views known on these proposed zoning actions.
